April was primarily about studying and attending the lectures for most of you, except for the graduating students, who already started to prepare for their exams and final exam.

On 10 April, the delegation of the Mongolian University of Life Sciences visited our faculty and met the management, lecturers as well as students from Mongolia studying at our university. Based on the discussions, the two institutions signed a Memorandum of Understanding about the future cooperation.

In April, during the project week, most of the students took some visits to various places in Hungary and in Europe, mainly getting involved in Easter traditions.

On 12 May, the Rural Development and Agribusiness 1st year master students visited the Balaton Limnological Institute of the Hungarian Academy of Science and had a lecture there delivered by our professor László G. Tóth, the head of the Institute. The group could also take a visit to Tihany.



On the 3rd week of May, the final exams for the international bachelor and masters students took place where they defended their theses and proved that they deserve the diploma based on their complex knowledge. We are very proud of their results, meaning

that out of 32 students, 21 will be awarded a diploma with very good or excellent grade. It really proves the joint hard work of students and lecturers.



On 25 May, the Ministry of Agriculture, Department of FAO and EU relations organized a farewell ceremony for the graduating FAO scholars in the ministry, where the regional representative of the FAO, Mr. Vladimir Rakhmanin hold the keynote speech. Until now 250 scholars from over 30 countries have graduated in Hungary, including our faculty, due to this scholarship opportunity.



The official graduation ceremony of the faculty will take place on 10 June 2017 from 10.00 am in the Aula. Anyone can come, you do not need invitation, so I would encourage all those who are interested to come and celebrate together with the graduating students as their family members in Gödöllő!
